Sub.: Rules Governing Bachelor of Optometry Degree Courses Examinations applicable for the students admitted w.e.f. Academic Year 2017-2018 and onwards ...

It is notified to all concerned that prescribed syllabus for **Bachelor of Optometry Degree Courses**, which is made applicable by the University for all students admitted w.e.f. Academic Year 2017-2018.

(1) NOMENCLATURE OF DEGREE:

The Nomenclature of Degree as follows:

(2) Period of Training:-

The student shall have to undergo study for a period of three years and one year internship after the admission.

(3) Attendance:

Every candidate is required to have minimum 75 % attendance in Theory & 80% attendance in Practical separately during each Academic Year to be eligible for the examination.

(4) Schedule of Examinations:-

University shall conduct Bachelor of Optometry Examinations at the end of every Academic Year, as per the time schedule as prescribed by the University from time to time. The University shall not conduct more than two examinations in a year.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATIONS FOR BACHELOR OF OPTOMETRY COURSE

A) Scheme for Theory Examinations:-

Each paper shall be of 100 marks and duration of each paper shall be 03 hours. Pattern of question paper shall be as given below.

B) Scheme for Practical Examinations:-

Clinical/Practical examinations shall be conducted to test the knowledge and competence of the candidates for undertaking independent work as a technician.

The maximum number of candidate to be examined in Clinical/ Practical and Oral on any day shall not exceed more than 25 students per batch.

(5) Passing Head and Standard of Passing:-

Every candidate has to secure minimum 50% marks in each paper of Theory, Practical separately.

In case,

- if any candidate passes in theory examination, however fails in Practical Examination, the respective candidate has to appear in Practical examination only.
- If any candidate fails in any theory paper the respective candidate have to reappear in fails subject only.

(6) Applicability of ATKT Facility:

- ATKT facility will be applicable to Bachelor of Optometry course upto 3rd year examination.
- Candidate who fails in any subject of 1st year Bachelor of Optometry course shall be permitted to prosecute studies of 2nd year, however, the candidate shall not be allowed to appear for the 2nd year examination, till such time that the candidate has passed all subjects of the 1st Year Bachelor of Optometry Course.

- 3) Candidate who fails in any subject of 2nd year Bachelor of Optometry course shall be permitted to prosecute studies of 3rd year, however, the candidate shall not be allowed to appear for the 3rd year examination, till such time that the candidate has passed all subjects of the 2nd Year Bachelor of Optometry Course.
- 4) In case of ATKT candidate (1st Failures), he/she shall not be permitted to prosecute studies of 3rd Bachelor of Optometry, till such time the candidate Passes in all subjects of 1st Bachelor of Optometry.

(7) Appointment of Examiner
